

2020-2021 PREP School Year

PREP- Registration forms are available on the QOPCC website, at church or can be emailed to you. Please complete the form and return it in person, by fax or email to Vickie Stirek. This year we will be doing distance learning for the fall semester. Each registered child will receive a textbook and a packet with lessons and worksheets to be completed at home. Packet pick-up is Sunday from 9:00am-10:00am, Tue-Thur 10:00am-2:00am. Contact Vickie at 662-895-5007 or youthcordms6@gmail.com for questions.

FIRST COMMUNION-Starting in October we will meet with parents of year one and year two 1st Communion students once a month. (**Children will not attend**) This will allow us to check in, collect work, hand out packets for the following month, lend support and give any pointers on teaching your children at home. Schedule for classes will be provided in the September packet.

GRADES 3-5 will only do distance learning until classes resume. Each month parents will pick up a packet and return work completed by their child.

CONFIRMATION 2020 (Yr 3), 2021 (Yr 2) and 2022 (Yr 1): Also starting in October students will attend class once a month. This will allow students to meet with their teacher and ask questions, hand in classwork, and pick up next month's packet. Schedule of classes will be provided in the September packet.

As things are continually changing this is the best way for me to contact every parent with updates, changes, and messages regarding your child's class.
